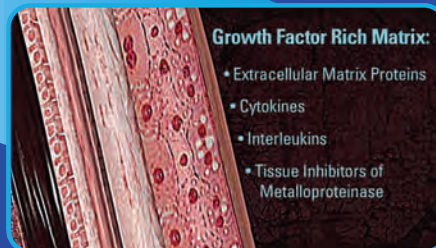

Stewart Balikov DDS

Health Care Fraud Investigator

Dr Balikov received his DDS from the USC School of Dentistry. He currently holds the position of National Dental Director Utilization Management for Aetna. Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon

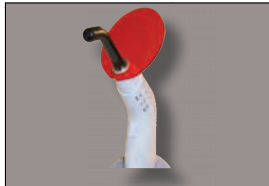
